

Mutufu Prison

- Mutufu Prison is on the foothills of Mount Elgon near Sironko and serves that area for remand prisoners and those convicted. Prisoners go every day to court.

Access has been allowed through the representation of Joseph Kunikina and the kindness of the Senior Officers, James initially and now the new Senior Officer.

James said the prisoners take your words very seriously and they are much easier to look after once you have been here, so you are always welcome.

The photo is from the outside and is of the old prison. A new one has been open for about 18 months very near the old one. Security of course prevents photos inside.

We have seen many prisoners receive the Lord Jesus, up to 70 or so on 2 occasions and many for prayer, last time. The Lord has not only saved the prisoners but many have been released as justice has been done for them. It is a remarkable testimony and former prisoners will visit Joseph at the school and tell him they were 'saved' in the prison and how God has blessed them, brought them justice and they are serving Him now. Thank you to all the prison staff who make us welcome and help with all the arrangements

One of the joys is to hear the prisoners sing Christian Songs. They do that as part of the meeting but just to bless us. It is unforgettable to hear them.
